Understanding Key Blackjack Terms



Hit

Taking another card from the dealer.



Double Down

Doubling your initial bet in exchange for committing to stand after receiving one more card.



Stand

Keeping your current hand without taking any more cards.



Split

If you're dealt two cards of the same value, you can split them into two separate hands and play each hand independently.



More Blackjack Terms

Surrender

Giving up your hand in exchange for half of your bet back (not all blackjack tables offer this option).

Push

When both the player and dealer have the same total, resulting in no winner.

Soft Hand

Any hand that includes an Ace that can be counted as either 1 or 11 without busting.

8 or less	Any	Hit
9	3-6	Double down
9	2, 7-A	Hit
10	2-9	Double down
10	10-A	Hit
11	2-10	Double down
11	A	Hit

Blackjack Cheat Sheet: Hard Totals

▼ Hard Totals 12-16

Player's Total 12-16: Stand if the dealer has 2-6, otherwise hit

▼ Hard Total 17 or Higher

Player's Total 17 or higher: Always stand

▼ Hard Total 11 or Lower

Player's Total 11 or lower: Always hit, except when doubling down is recommended

Blackjack Cheat Sheet: Soft Totals

1

Soft 13-15

Soft 13-15 (Ace + 2-4): Hit

2

Soft 16-18

Soft 16-18 (Ace + 5-7): Double down if the dealer has 4-6, otherwise hit

3

Soft 19-21

Soft 19-21 (Ace + 8-10): Always stand

Blackjack Cheat Sheet: Pair Splitting



2s, 3s, 6s, 7s, 9s

Pairs of 2s, 3s, 6s, 7s, 9s: Split if the dealer has 2-6, otherwise hit



Aces

Pairs of Aces: Always split



8s

Pairs of 8s: Always split



10s

Pairs of 10s: Always stand



Importance of Consistent Strategy
